In January we were joined by 2 new members of staff. Aleyna joined Big Einstein and Feride joined Faraday. We welcome them both to the nursery.


Children have been learning about people who help us and transport through a range of activities. It has been lovely to see the new learning taking place and building on children's current knowledge.
