Little Einstein -

This month the children have explored nursery rhymes and story time theme. We covered lots of different stories and focused on activities around them, the children enjoyed sticking with cotton wool on sheep for 'little bo peep' and lots of hand print painting for things to do with the nursery rhyme of the week. The children enjoyed joining in at song time with lots of different instruments and showing an interest in the way they sound and have enjoyed dancing and doing the actions to songs they enjoy.

Big Einstein;

For the past two months in Big Einstein we have been looking at stories and nursery rhymes. We have been focusing on a book a week, the children have really enjoyed focusing on Dear Zoo, Elmer, goldilocks, the three little pigs. To bring the theme in to our areas in the room we created a construction area for the three little pigs and the children enjoyed using different building resources to create their houses, wearing the pig masks and playing alongside their peers. Whilst looking at the hungry caterpillar book, the children have enjoyed doing a range of food tasting activities. For nursery rhyme week we have been focusing on the children's favourite rhymes and have been playing with black trays based on the rhyme and children have enjoyed joining in with the actions and vocalizations.

We have been looking at nursery rhymes and traditional tales, the children have enjoyed building houses out of sticks, straws and hay and decorating houses too. The children also did activities based on jack and the bean stalk, we made beanstalk soup and the children enjoyed playing with the 'magic beans' We have been doing lots of activities to do with physical development and have been creating obstacle courses in the garden.


The children have recently been taking part in dough-disco and have really enjoyed it.

The children have enjoyed a range of messy tray activities and been very engaged, we have been working on our fine motor movements and have been trying to pick up pasta and other objects using tweezers.




Faraday -
